



SEMINAR: RURAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP WITHOUT LIMITS

14 - 21 OF MARCH

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

Rural entrepreneurship without limits is a **seminar** that will gather entities with expertise in different fields in the area of **rural entrepreneurship** to share their experience and reflect on **how we can promote it among young people**.

During six days we are going to discuss good practices in rural entrepreneurship (Crafting, Agriculture, Rural tourism, cultural management, digitalization, and cattle raising), we will share different tools, meet with role models, reflect on how each of us works with young people, discuss how we can facilitate young people entrepreneurship and make networking activities.

Our purpose will be to put a seed for a new Network and for different initiatives at European level with the purpose of promoting rural entrepreneurship among young people, searching the correct pathways to give youngsters the opportunity to create their own life project in the rural context, at the same we protect rural heritage.

MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THE SEMINAR

- To develop competencies related with the promotion of entrepreneurship in the rural context of 20 youth workers from 10 different countries in Europe through exchanging of good practices, approach rural digitalization strategies, acquiring key tools and learning by others.
- To create a new network of entities from different parts of Europe for the creation of new initiatives and projects in the promotion of rural development and youth dynamization in European rural contexts.
- To create a handbook aimed at youth workers working in rural areas to facilitate the promotion of rural entrepreneurship, adding the gender perspective. This handbook will contain examples of good practices, tools used in the project, digitalization strategies, and the different reflections done in the project.

WHERE?


The project will be implemented in the rural town of Robledo (Albacete province).
